Circular Migration and Employment: Opportunities for Businesses in a Changing Mediterranean

In a context of evolving labor markets and strengthened cooperation between Europe and the Mediterranean, this event aims to highlight the opportunities offered by circular migration mechanisms, with a particular focus on the **NET-Work You** initiative and the role of Italian enterprises.

The **NET-Work You project** is implemented by Confcooperative Puglia and CIHEAM Bari within the framework of the Migration Partnership Facility (MPF), an initiative funded by the European Union and implemented by ICMPD. With a duration of 36 months, the project seeks to develop a sustainable model of qualified circular labor mobility between Italy and Egypt.

Through training programs and internships in Puglia targeting young Egyptians – recent graduates in ICT and agricultural technicians – the initiative aims to strengthen skills in the green agriculture, digital, and sustainable economy sectors, thereby improving employability and fostering connections between enterprises and institutions in both countries.

The creation of a Mediterranean multi-stakeholder network will complement the action, promoting public-private partnerships and the exchange of good practices at national and European levels.

The seminar will explore opportunities for cooperation between the two countries and for the empowerment of young professionals, promoting in its first part an exchange among institutions, and in the second part a discussion among labor agencies and the local business system.
