## ANNEX III – Technical specifications

### Minimum technical Requirements:

Tenderers must provide:

- Supply of a Niskin water sampling bottle suitable for biological and environmental marine sampling activities.
- Bottle made of non-contaminating materials suitable for seawater sampling.
- Minimum sampling capacity of 5 liters.
- Equipped with messenger weight closing system and rope/cable suitable for marine sampling operations.

Compliance with the above minimum technical requirements shall be assessed on a pass/fail basis and substantiated through the submitted documents (e.g. Technical datasheet; Quotation).

Offers that do not meet the minimum technical requirements shall be rejected.

Duration of the offers: the offer will be valid for 60 days.

Contract duration: 1 month.
