CIHEAM Bari invites experts to apply for consultancy position as **RESEARCH AGRONOMIST – IRRIGATION, CROP PHYSIOLOGY & DIGITAL AGRICULTURE**.

As per *CIHEAM Staff Regulation and the Statute of Consultants, Experts and Auxiliary staff*, (Text adopted by decision 59(84)12), to meet temporary training, research and cooperation requirements, CIHEAM Bari may appoint experts and consultants (as per *CIHEAM Bari Management Framework and Administrative Procedures*). Consultant's tasks are results-oriented including analyzing problems, conducting and organizing seminars and training courses, preparing documents for conferences and meetings, drafting reports on topics related to the area of expertise.

Qualified female applicants are encouraged to apply for this position as CIHEAM Bari aims to ensure an inclusive working environment and is committed to achieve a gender-balanced staff.

1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

Job title: Research Agronomist – Irrigation, Crop Physiology & Digital Agriculture.

Duty station: CIHEAM Bari, Valenzano (BA)

Contract and Remuneration: Consultancy conditions, remuneration, and related benefits are governed by CIHEAM Bari rules and regulations. The final fee will be commensurate with the selected candidate's seniority, relevant expertise, and assigned responsibilities.

Duration of the assignment: contract of 12 months (initial three-month probationary period)

Line Manager: The position reports directly to the Head of the Thematic Unit "Water & Land" in the frame of the Scientific Area of CIHEAM Bari, or a formally appointed delegate.

2. KEY FUNCTIONS

During the performance of the assignment, the Research Agronomist will be responsible for:

- Actively contribute to applied and experimental research in agronomy, with a focus on irrigation management, crop physiology, and soil–water–plant interactions.
- Design, implement, and monitor field and controlled experiments, ensuring scientific rigor and reproducibility.
- Analyze and interpret experimental data, contributing to scientific outputs (reports, technical papers, and peer-reviewed publications).



- Support the integration of digital agriculture tools (e.g., sensors, monitoring systems, data platforms) to enhance research quality and irrigation management.
- Contribute to the development of research proposals and participate in project reporting within national and international programs.
- Collaborate with team members across disciplines, contributing to a shared research agenda and joint outputs.
- Contribute to training, teaching, and capacity-building activities, linking research results with education and knowledge transfer.
- Participate in international cooperation projects, ensuring alignment between research activities and development-oriented objectives.

3. QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS REQUIRED

Candidates will be considered eligible for selection based on the following essential requirements, to be fulfilled by the deadline for applications:

- PhD in Agronomy, Irrigation Science, Crop Physiology, or related fields.
- Proven experience in experimental research, including design, data collection, and analysis under field conditions.
- Strong knowledge of soil–water–plant relationships and irrigation practices.
- Demonstrated ability to contribute to scientific writing and dissemination (e.g., reports, publications, conferences).
- Experience with digital agriculture tools as a complementary skill.
- Ability to work in collaborative, multidisciplinary, and international environments.
- Interest or experience in training, education, and international cooperation projects.
- English (C1 level required: mandatory).
